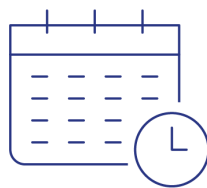
Wetland-based solutions for climate change adaptation, risk prevention and mitigation

OUR PROJECT

Wetland4Change aims to validate transferable solutions based on **wetland conservation and restoration** for climate adaptation and mitigation, in order to accelerate the capacities of **wetland managers** and of policy makers to cope with the **climate crisis** at local and transnational level, by improving take up of science-based knowledge and governance mechanisms, through assessments, guidance, experience exchange, capacity building and replication. The main project outputs are: two wetland-based solutions for **carbon-sequestration** and for **flood regulation**.
